Tableau Forensic Imager (TX1)

In the lab, or in the field, the Tableau Forensic Imager (TX1) acquires more data, faster, from more media types, without ever sacrificing ease-of-use or portability.

Every component is hand-selected and tested to guarantee reliability and performance when conducting forensic imaging operations. TX1 features include:

- Superior local and network imaging performance without compromise
- Broad media support including SATA, USB 3, PCIe, SAS, FireWire 800, IDE, and network shares over a 10 GbE network connection
- Up to four destinations per source (1:4) with the ability to mix clone/image duplication and local/network destinations (outputs to SATA, USB 3, SAS, and network shares)
- Beautiful and intuitive user interface
- Support for up to two active “forensic” jobs at a time (simultaneous imaging)
- Job queuing option for efficiency and convenience
- Media Utility options of: view drive details, wipe, format, manage encryption (AES-XTS), view & disable HPA/DCO, blank check, browse filesystem, view SMART, export as iSCSI target for remote access, and eject media
- On screen real-time notifications/feedback with audible feedback options

Similar to the already available Tableau PCIe Adapters, the Tableau TDA7-3 allows users to image Apple PCIe SSDs in a forensically-sound manner through any PCIe-compatible Tableau product.
